## Reopening Day at Apple Blossom – 8<sup>th</sup> January'26

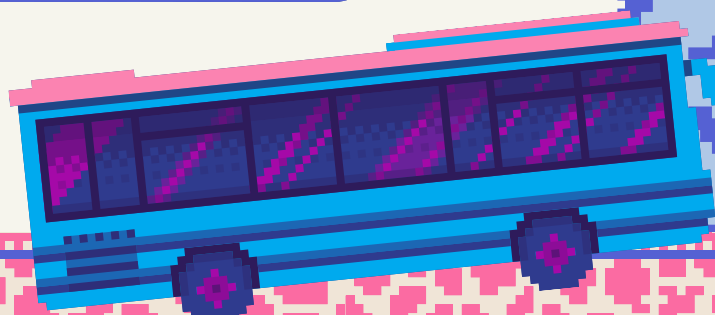
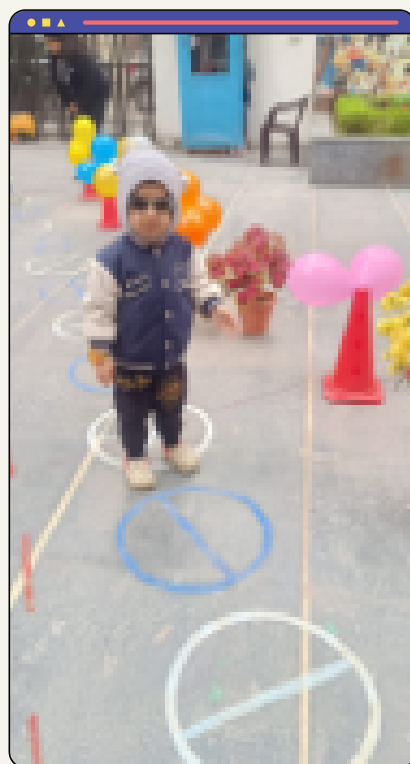
