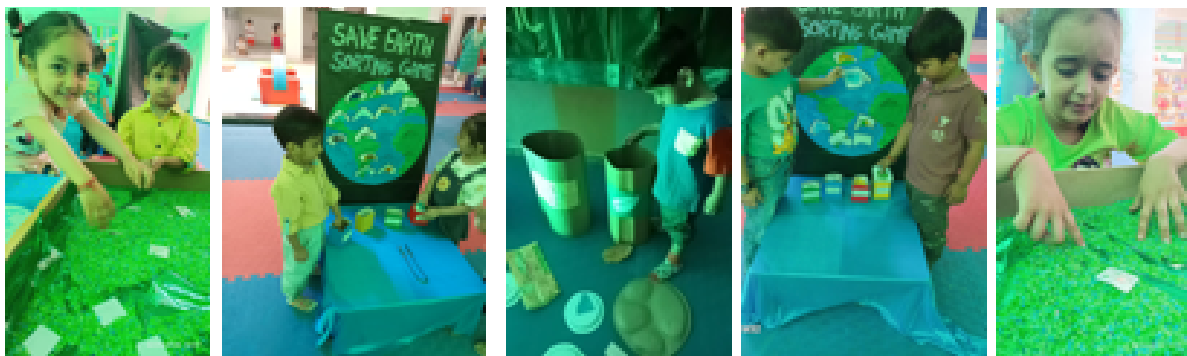
## Earth Day Celebrations – 22<sup>nd</sup> April '26

The day ended with an Earth Pledge, and every child went home as a proud “Earth Hero.”





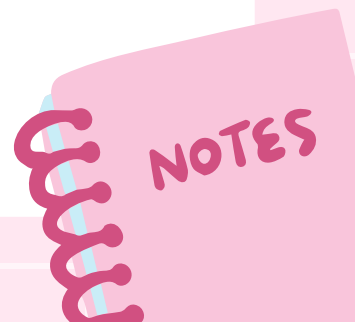
## Story Giraffe Can't Dance – 27<sup>th</sup> April '26
