The three-day Krishna Leela at Apple Blossom was a beautiful journey into devotion, culture, and joy.

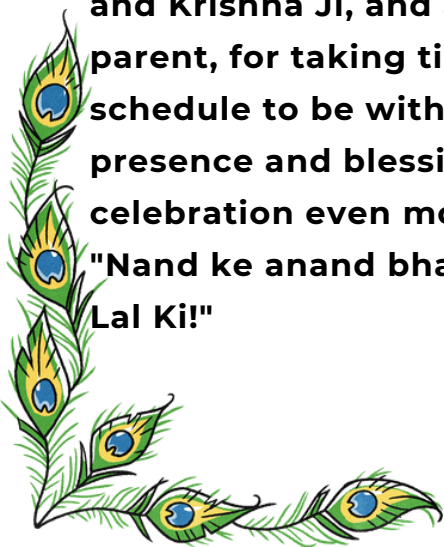

"Nand ke anand bhayo, Jai Kanhaiya Lal Ki!"



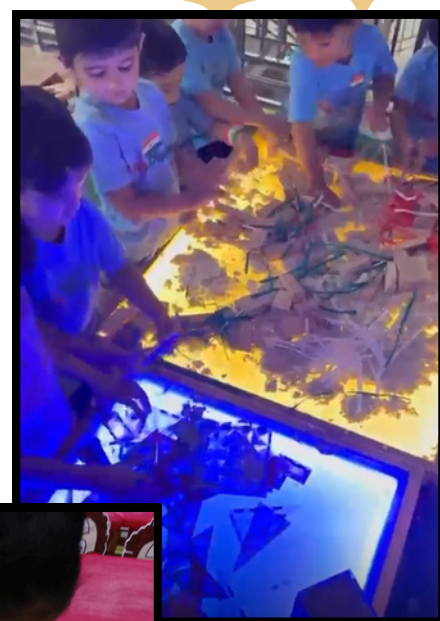
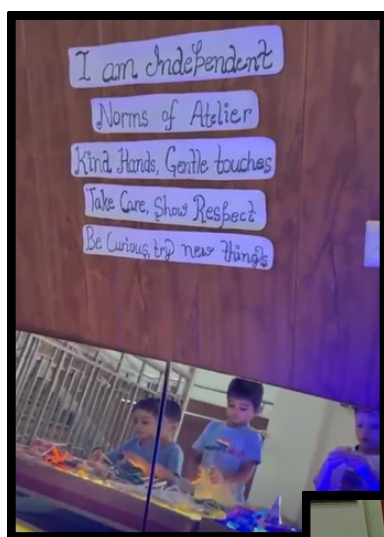
I AM INDEPENDENT ATELIER: A JOURNEY OF LITTLE EXPLORERS 🌱
