


1ST JULY' 25 - WANDER AND WONDER: WELCOME BACK!

The kids dived into six fun-filled activities that sparked curiosity and creativity:




- 2. Fort Adventures: Building and exploring forts, fostering imagination and teamwork.
















22ND JULY'25 - NATIONAL FLAG DAY

These activities not only taught our young learners about the national flag but also fostered a sense of national pride and unity.



























26TH JULY'25 - ASSEMBLY ON SOLAR ENERGY


