SUMMER

Girls	
 Half sleeved white shirt (with proper collar) with green blue check piping and green check border on sleeves with stripes stitched on both the shoulders. Green blue check tunic skirt (No bottle green belt required). White socks (long) with two green stripes and black velcro shoes. Bottle green ribbon/hair band. White slips under shirt and white bloomer should always be worn. No tie and badge for Classes Prep Junior and Prep Senior. 	

Boys

- Half sleeved white shirt (with proper collar) with green blue check suiting collar and border on the sleeves and pocket.
- Green blue check shorts with elastic (without zip).
- Bottle green belt with school logo.
- White socks with two green stripes and black Velcro shoes.
- Bottle green colour putka for Sikh boys.
- White vest should always be worn under shirt.

WINTER

For both Boys & Girls

- Full sleeved T-shirt with proper collar (as per approved pattern).
- Full sleeved jacket (as per approved pattern).
- Trousers with elastic (without zip).
- Bottle green cap grey warm socks (long) with two green stripes and black velcro shoes.
- Bottle green colour putka for Sikh boys and bottle green cap for others.
- White vest should always be worn under T-shirt by the boys.
- White slips should always be worn under T-shirt by the girls.

No tie and badge for Classes Prep Junior and Prep Senior.

Girls (Classes I to VIII)

- White half-sleeved shirt (with proper collar).
- White single pleated skirt (till the knees).
- Bottle green school tie and house badge for class IV to VIII. (No school tie for classes | to |||)
- Bottle green belt with school emblem.
- Bottle green ribbon/band.
- · White socks (knee length) with two green stripes
- Plain black shoes with strap and buckle (non-leather medium toe).
- White slips under shirt and white cycling shorts should always be worn.

- Mafatlal Brand 999 quality for skirt.

Girls (Classes IX to XII)

- White half-sleeved kurta with mandarin collar. Collar is made of check fabric and piping of striped fabric is on sleeves.
- Striped trouser style salwar with piping.
- Jacket of striped fabric with school monogram
- Bottle green ribbon/band.
- White socks with two green stripes.
- Plain black shoes with strap and buckle (non-leather medium toe).
- White slips under shirt should always be worn.

Specification of the fabric:

- Mafatlal Brand -White Rose' quality PC fabric for shirts.
- Mafatlal (Tantra design no 4) for trouser and jacket.
- Check fabric used for collar is of Mafatlal (Tantra design no 3).

Boys (Classes I to XII)

- White half-sleeved shirt (with proper collar).
- White shorts (not more than 2" above the knees) for class to I to VIII.
- White straight trousers with two pleats for class IX to XII.
- · Bottle green school tie and house badge for class IV to XII (No school tie for classes I to III)
- Bottle green belt with school emblem.
- Bottle green putka or turban for Sikh boys.
- White socks (long) with two green stripes.
- Plain black shoes with laces (non-leather medium toe).
- White vest should always be worn under shirt.

Sports Uniform

Kindly Note: The school has no authorized tailor shop.

The parents are free to buy the uniform from any shop. However, the exact uniform specifications as given above are to be followed before purchasing the uniform.

- 1. The student should take pride in wearing the school uniform.
- 2. Students are expected to attend school in neat and well ironed, complete uniform. Non-Sikh boys should have short and decent haircut. In case of non-compliance, they will not be allowed to attend classes and parents shall be called to take them home. Kindly ensure that the instructions are followed with all seriousness to avoid any inconvenience to your good self later.
- 3. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ENTER SCHOOL CAMPUS ONLY IN SCHOOL UNIFORM AND NOT IN CIVIL OUTFIT EVEN FOR THE PURPOSE OTHER THAN ACADEMIC.
- 4. They must also be in uniform when representing the school in any Inter school events or programme.
- 5. Girls must wear knee-length skirt. Girls must tie their hair neatly in two plaits with bottle green hair band/ ribbon (no other colour is allowed). No fancy hair clips or jewellery is allowed.
- 6. The trousers should be straight having two pleats. Fancy trousers are not permitted.
- 7. White shoes must be worn only for games or on PT day. However, on all formal occasions, students are expected to wear black shoes.
- 8. Parents must ensure that their wards wear only white under clothes (white slips for girls and white vest for boys). It is mandatory for girls to wear white cycling shots / bloomers under their skirts/tunics.
