This year's summer assignment, option number 1, for English is based on the book “Adventure in Kaziranga” four environment novellas by Arup Kumar Dutta. These stories are set in the beautiful state of Assam, which is home to the world– famous Kaziranga National park. It is a wildlife sanctuary where the guards protect the animals of Kaziranga from their main enemy – man. We want our students to raise their level of awareness regarding conservation of Nature and wildlife animals. All sixth graders are going to be a part of a huge anti – poaching forum and everyone will showcase their love for animals!

**Choose to do ANY ONE of the following. Option number 1 is with reference to**

**‘Adventures in Kaziranga’.**

1. Look at the picture on page 89. Write a short paragraph in your grammar notebook, using your imagination and your knowledge about elephants. Describe the relationship between a baby elephant and its father or mother. Do these gentle giants show protective feelings like humans? Provide your answer in your paragraph. Attach a photocopy of this picture to your notebook, next to the paragraph. If anyone is good at drawing, try to draw the picture in the notebook.
2. Kaziranga National Park in Assam is home to the endangered Great Indian Rhinoceros. Make a colourful collage on a standard A3 sheet using pictures, slogans, information about any one wildlife sanctuary in India. You can choose from:
  - Kaziranga Wildlife Sanctuary, Assam
  - Bandhavgarh National Park, Madhya Pradesh
  - Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand.
  - Ranthambore National Park, Rajasthan.

You may write about a trip to any of these places in your journal.

3. Use 2 A4 sheets to do the following task. Create a profile of the famous author Ruskin Bond. Put pictures and interesting information about him and his books. Write an additional note on one page about Ruskin Bond’s relationship with Nature.
4. Use 2 A4 pages to write a description of yourself as a protector of the environment. Write 2,3 paragraphs on how you are preserving the greenery and appreciating the wildlife and scenery as you travel within India. Make an informative and interesting profile that can be used in the school Yearbook too. Provide the title: ‘Goenka Eco-Tourist !

3. **COLLAGE POSTER/TRAVEL BROCHURE:** Organize your COLLAGE POSTER /TRAVEL **BROCHURE to include:** - Cover page with the tribe's name and your name.(Brochure only ) - Introduction to the tribe and their geographical location. - Description of the tribe's traditional handicrafts. - Images or diagrams of the handicrafts. - Conclusion summarizing the importance of preserving tribal handicrafts.
4. **Presentation:** Prepare a visually appealing COLLAGE POSTER/TRAVEL BROCHURE using: - Colorful charts, diagrams, or pictures. - Clear and concise writing. - Proper headings and subheadings.
5. **Submission:** Submit your work on the designated date, ensuring it is neatly organized and well-presented.
