REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION //

Registration for admission does not guarantee confirmation. Admission is subject to further evaluation and fulfilment of eligibility criteria.

The name of the applicant will be registered on receipt of the application for admission duly completed. Filled in application can be sent to the following address along with the account payee cheque for Rs. 5200/- towards registration in favour of Lala Kamlapat Singhania Education Centre, payable at UCO Bank, Gotan / SBI Bank, Gotan or can be paid in cash.

Date of birth, as recorded in the previous school leaving certificates countersigned by the District Education Officer of the state will be considered final and no application for change in the date of birth will subsequently be entertained.

Parents and guardians must, therefore, ensure that these entries are made correctly in the admission form.

The Student appearing for admission is to produce mark sheet as a proof of his/her having passed the previous class. The provisional admission is confirmed, only when a school leaving certificate from the school last attended countersigned by the District Education Officer is produced. In case certificate is not submitted by July 15, the scholar's name will be struck off from the school rolls. If a student gets the admission, the parent/guardian is required to deposit the school fee for the first term immediately, failing which the selection would be treated as cancelled. If a candidate fails to report back within seven days from the date of confirmed admission, his/her seat will be declared vacant and the fee deposited will not be refunded.

ADMISSION TO CLASS XI

Students seeking admission to class XI (Humanities, Commerce and Science streams) should get their names registered and send an attested copy of the marks-sheet of class X Board Examination within a week of the declaration of the result. Admission to class XI is made on the basis of pre-board and half yearly exam. The Principal reserves the right to accept or reject any application for admission without assigning any reason. Application for registration cum admission should be sent to **Principal, L K Singhania Education Centre, Gotan-342902 (Raj.)**

WITHDRAWALS

Parents who wish to withdraw their children from the school should give a notice to the Principal in writing at least one month prior to the date of withdrawal. In case, withdrawal is made in the middle of the academic year, then the dues up to the end of the year should be remitted.

DISCIPLINE

Our institution is committed to maintaining a culture of discipline, respect, and responsibility. To achieve this, we have established clear guidelines for behavior and consequences for misconduct. Any behavior that compromises the safety, well-being, or integrity of our community, including but not limited to insubordination, disobedience, theft, fraud, damage to school property, unapproved absences, habitual tardiness, and smoking, may result in disciplinary action. This may include suspension, expulsion, or rustication, depending on the severity of the offense.

SCHOOL RULES

1. Parents/guardians are to abide by the school rules in all respects which are subjected to change from time to time. In all matters of dispute, the decision of the Principal shall be binding and final.
2. The parents/guardians must permit their wards to take part in compulsory activities like tour, treks, expeditions, camps etc. in accordance with the school rules.
3. The parents/guardians shall hold the school indemnified against all claims arising due to illness, accident or any other reason.
4. The parents/guardians will authorize the Principal and through him the staff of the school to act as guardian of their wards while they are in the school or on tours, treks, expedition, camps etc.
5. The parents/guardians will authorize the Principal to take necessary action on their behalf in case of emergency or any other such conditions where their permission is needed but cannot be obtained in time.
6. By enrolling their child, parents agree to pay the full year's fees, as determined by the school, in the event of withdrawal during the academic year, regardless of the circumstances.
7. Damage to the school property and the loss or damage of library books will be made good by the parents.
8. Parents/Guardians are requested to notify the Principal of any change of address or telephone number as all the correspondence will be made only to the address given to the office.
9. No student is allowed to drive vehicle of his/her parent or friends inside the campus.
10. Use and possession of mobile phone in the campus by the students is strictly prohibited.

LEAVE RULES

To maintain a safe and secure environment, parents/guardians must follow our leave policy. Before taking their child on leave, they must obtain prior approval from the Principal and collect a gate pass from the concerned Hostel In-charge. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary action and potential legal consequences. This policy applies to all instances, including when parents/guardians are staying in our school guest house.

FOOD PARCELS

To maintain a safe and inclusive environment, we have a no-food-parcel policy and discourage expensive birthday parties. Instead, parents can notify us, and we will arrange a modest celebration with a cake and sweets for the student's closest friends, coordinated by the housemaster. Please note that Amazon deliveries / online shopping will only be accepted with prior permission from the respective House Master. Students and parents must obtain approval before placing an order.

VALUABLES

To maintain a distraction-free and secure environment, we prohibit boarders from possessing cell phones, smart watches, and valuable items. Please note that the school will not be liable for any loss or damage to personal belongings.

MONETARY AND OTHER TRANSACTIONS

Nobody is permitted to buy or sell or exchange goods or lend or borrow money. Anyone found flouting this rule shall be dealt with most severely.

For outstation parents, please provide advance notice of your visit to facilitate arrangements for your stay in our school guest house. Please also carry a parental authorization letter for verification purposes.

TRAVELLING ARRANGEMENT

The school is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students. We will provide an escort for large groups of students travelling from the same location. However, parents are responsible for arranging their child's transportation to and from school at the beginning and end of each term. Please note that we require written parental authorization for students to leave school unescorted.
