L K Singhania Education Centre is a coeducational, English medium school having classes Nursery to class 8<sup>th</sup> accommodating 600 students. This centre is a multicultural school where traditions, religions and beliefs are respected and celebrated.

To be a centre of excellence in holistic education that nurtures confident, compassionate, and responsible global citizens, rooted in strong values and committed to lifelong learning.

## **OBJECTIVE**

This centre is committed to providing the highest standard of education not only to the wards of J K employees but to everyone in and around Harduwaken. Our school community is dedicated to providing a safe, secure and conducive environment where all the children can develop their skills and talents in a variety of ways and to the best of their abilities. We want the children to feel confident, to see themselves as successful learners, and to have responsible attitudes towards themselves and others. Alongside academic excellence, we inspire students to uphold our cultural heritage and empower them to adapt to the evolving challenges of the modern world.

## **LOCATION**

Harduwaken is a small village in the District of Panna, Madhya Pradesh. The school is located in a beautiful campus. Harduwaken is an industrial township and easily accessible by road. Bus services from Panna, Satna and Katni are very frequent and easily available via Amanganj. The nearest airport is only 100 kilometer from the school in Khajuraho.

## **REGISTRATION & ADMISSION**

The registration of a student seeking admission does not necessarily entitle the student for confirmation. The name of the applicant will be registered on receipt of the application for admission duly completed. Filled in application can be submitted to the school office with the amount of Rs. 13,200/- towards registration & admission fee in favour of Lala Kamlapat Singhania Education Centre. Date of birth, as recorded in the previous school leaving certificates countersigned by the District Education Officer of the state or as in the Aadhaar Card will be considered final and no application for change in the date of birth will subsequently be entertained. Parents and guardians must, therefore, ensure that these entries are made correctly in the admission form.

The Student appearing for admission is to produce mark sheet as a proof of his/her having passed the previous class. The provisional admission is confirmed, only when a school leaving certificate from the school last attended countersigned by the District Education Officer is produced. In case certificate is not submitted by July 15, the scholar's name will be struck off from the school rolls. If a student gets the admission, the parent/guardian is required to deposit the school fee for the first term immediately, failing which the selection would be treated as cancelled. If a candidate fails to report back within seven days from the date of confirmed admission, his/her seat is declared vacant and the fee deposited will not be refunded.

## **WITHDRAWALS**

Parents who wish to withdraw their children from the school should give a notice to the Principal in writing at least one month prior to the date of withdrawal. In case, withdrawal is made in the middle of the academic year, then the due up to the end of the year should be remitted.

## SCHOOL RULES

- Parents/guardians are to abide by the school rules in all respects which are subjected to change from time to time. In all matters of dispute, the decision of the Principal shall be binding and final.
- The parents/guardians must permit their wards to take part in compulsory activities like tour, treks, expeditions, camps etc. in accordance with the school rules.
- The parents/guardians shall hold the school indemnified against all claims arising due to illness, accident or any other reason.
- The parents/guardians will authorize the Principal and through him the staff of the school to act as guardian of their wards while they are in the school or on tours, treks, expedition, camps etc.
- The parents/guardians will authorize the Principal to take necessary action on their behalf in case of emergency or any other such conditions where their permission is needed but cannot be obtained in time.
- The parents/guardians will agree that in the event of their child/children being withdrawn during the course of the year whatever the reason, the full fee laid by the school for the whole year will be paid by them.
- Damage to the school property and the loss or damage of library books will be made good by the parents
- Parents/ Guardians are requested to notify the Principal of any change of address or telephone number as all the correspondence will be made only to the address given to the office.
- No student is allowed to drive vehicle of his/her parent or friends inside the campus.
- Use and possession of mobile phone in the campus by the students is strictly prohibited.

## **DISCIPLINE**

We believe in discipline with firmness. A student may be suspended/expelled/rusticated if he/ she is found to be guilty of misconduct, in subordination, disobedience, theft, fraud, damage to or loss of school's goods or property, absence without leave for more than 10 days, habitual late attendance etc. smoking, conviction in any court of law for any criminal offence involving moral turpitude, giving false information, threatening, abusing or assaulting any school employee or student, abetment of or attempt at abetment of any of the above, failure or refusal to wear school uniform, any action which adversely affects the good governance of the institution

## **LEAVE RULES**

In case the parents/guardians want to take their child/children on any leave, they must obtain a prior permission from the Principal through a WhatsApp message or in person. After getting the approval by the Principal, they must get the gate pass from the concerned class teacher. If they take their ward out of school campus without the gate pass, it will be treated as indiscipline and may lead to a legal action by the school.

## **FOOD PARCELS**

Parcels containing junk foods are not allowed. Expensive parties to celebrate birthday are not allowed. With the permission of the Principal, a student may distribute the chocolates to the fellow mates and teachers.

## **VALUABLES**

Cell Phones, Smart Watches and costly articles are not allowed in possession of any student. In case of any loss of valuables or other articles, the school shall not take any responsibility.

## **MONETARY AND OTHER TRANSACTIONS**

Nobody is permitted to buy or sell or exchange goods or lend or borrow money. Anyone found flouting this rule shall be dealt with most severely.

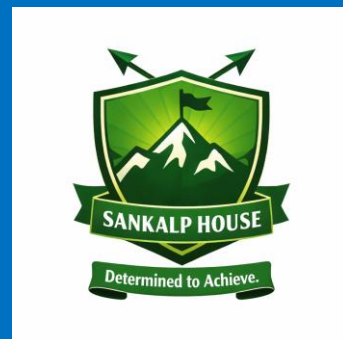

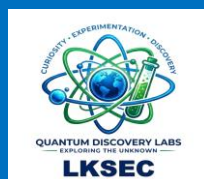
