MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BODY MEETING OF NPSC HELD ON FRIDAY, 28 NOVEMBER 2025 AT 03.00 P.M.

The General Body Meeting of NPSC was held at Modern School, Vasant Vihar, Delhi on Friday, 28 November 2025. It was attended by 41 members.

The Chairperson initiated the meeting by extending a warm welcome to all attending members and expressed appreciation for their continued participation and valuable contributions to the initiatives of NPSC.

Agenda-1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The members were informed that the minutes of the previous meeting held on 15 October 2025 had been circulated via email to all Executive Body members.

As no observations or amendments were received, the minutes were confirmed and approved unanimously by the members present.

Agenda-3: Address by Dr. Sanyam Bhardwaj, Controller of Examination, CBSE, New Delhi followed by Q&A session:

Dr. Sanyam Bhardwaj, Controller of Examination, CBSE, New Delhi graciously agreed to address the Principals of NPSC Member schools in the GBM and discussed the following in his address cum QA session:

- Dr. Bhardwaj recalled and appreciated his long association with NPSC and conveyed his best wishes to the new team. He acknowledged NPSC as one of the leading and trendsetting

organization, whose collective initiatives and inputs are viewed with a lot of seriousness and respect by all stakeholders.

- In his address, Mr. Bhardwaj not only discussed the Boards preparation for the forthcoming two board examinations at length, but he also appealed the schools Principals to counsel the students and parents to deal with it in a better manner. He mentioned that this time board examination date sheet has been released well in advance for everyone to be well prepared. The successful conduction of Board Exams lies in the fact that schools cooperate with CBSE in all the examination activities, as desired.
- Dr. Bhardwaj also apprised members about the seamless process of payment for all examination related activities through the portal and directly in the account of the participants in various examination related activities in a timely and fair manner as per the policies.
- Dr. Bhardwaj also answered various questions asked by the member schools with regards to the conduct of two board exams and examination related policies of the board like change in particulars of students in the LOC, short attendance, absence in the first board exam and eligibility for appearing in the second board examination for class X.

Members in the executive body meeting suggested that dedicated online activities be organized for students and teachers from outside Delhi NCR. This would allow them to actively participate in the initiatives and feel equally included. Such virtual engagements would help build a sense of camaraderie across different regions, ensuring that the community remains connected and involved regardless of the geographical distances.

There being no other point, the Chairperson, NPSC thanked Dr. Sanyam Bhardwaj and all the members for bringing their expertise and experience around the table and engaging in fruitful discussion. The meeting was closed with a vote of thanks to the host school for the gracious hospitality and excellent arrangements made for hosting the meeting.
