Proficiency Certificate

Proficiency Certificate is awarded to a child on the basis of the following criteria:

2. Students must score minimum A2 in General Awareness and Value Education.
3. Students must have 85% attendance.
4. Students must attain minimum grade B in Co-Scholastic subjects

Classes IV-XII

1. Scholar Badge

Classes IV & V

- a) Minimum grade points in 5 main subjects - 39
- b) Minimum A2 grade in all subjects
- c) 85% attendance.

Classes VI to VIII

- a) Minimum grade point in 6 main subjects – 46
- b) Minimum A2 grade in all subjects
- c) 85% attendance.

Classes IX to XII

- a) Minimum grade point in 5 main subjects - 38
- b) Minimum A2 grade in all subjects
- c) 85% attendance.

2. Scholar's Gown / Blazer

Scholar's Gown shall be awarded to the student who earns Scholar's Badge for three consecutive years.

3. Class Topper & Section Topper (Classes IV to XII)

These awards are based on aggregate marks obtained in a year.

4. Subject Topper's Certificate (Classes IV to XII)

Subject Topper's Certificate will be awarded to the student who has secured the highest in individual academic subjects. The minimum percentage required is 85%.

5. Gold Medal (for Class IX-XII)

A student is eligible to get a Gold Medal if:

- he/she has been a Scholar Badge Holders for all five consecutive years (i.e. in Class IV VIII).
- he/she should receive a Subject Topper Certificate in at least one subject for any 3 out of 4 years of Class IX- Class XII. (i.e. either in Class IX-X-XII or Class X-XI-XII or Class IX-XI-XII)

6. Mr. M. M. Singh Memorial Award (for Class XI)

This award is given to the student showing outstanding performance in Class XI - Science Stream.

7. J. R. D. Tata Award (for Class XI)

This award is given to the student showing outstanding performance in Class XI - Commerce Stream.

8. Rabindranath Tagore Award (for Class XI)

This award is given to the student showing outstanding performance in Class XI - Humanities Stream.

9. Prof. Sada Shiv Bhagat Memorial Medal (for Class XI)

This award is given to the student who score highest marks in English in class XI.

10. Anand Gupta Memorial Award (for Class XI)

This award of Rs. 5,000 is given to students scoring highest marks in Physics and Painting in class XI.

11. Shri Pawan Bakshi Memorial Mathematics Genius Award (for Class XI)

This award is given to the student who scores highest marks in Mathematics in class XI.

12. All Rounder Award (Class III - Class XI)

Award of All Rounder will be awarded to a student on yearly basis who will score minimum 20 points (Class III), 23 points (Classes IV & V) and 25 points (Classes VI-XII) in an academic year.

The criteria and points allotted are as follows:

a) Academics: A maximum of 9 points can be scored

b) Discipline: A maximum of 4 points can be scored.

The students will be assessed throughout the year and can earn maximum 5 points for a disciplined behaviour. These points will be awarded by the wing in-charges in discussion with the class teachers and feedback given by the subject teachers.

c) Attendance: A maximum of 4 points can be scored

Please note

1. Performing Arts include all music, dance, art, painting, co-curricular activities etc.
2. For a student to be an All-Rounder, he/she should have at least one participation in all three activity domains, i.e. D1, D2, D3.
3. As number of activities and exposure at different class levels is varying, therefore Total of each D1, D2, and D3 should be at least 1 (i.e. 1, 2, 3, etc) for Class III, at least 2 (i.e. 2, 3, 4 etc) for Class IV- V, at least 3 (i.e. 3, 4, 5, etc) for Class VI onwards.
4. Total sum contribution in activities can be subject to a maximum of 13 points.

13. Champion Award

It is awarded to the All Rounder for three consecutive years.

14. Principal Award

It is awarded to the All Rounder for five consecutive years.

15. Exemplar Award

It is awarded to the student for his/her extra-ordinary achievement.

16. Cups / Trophies

Following Rolling Trophies are awarded to the Best House for its achievements in the following areas:

- a) Academics
- b) Co-curricular Activities
- c) Discipline
- d) Games and Sports
- e) Cock House (Overall Best House)

Important Note:

For the awards of Scholar's Badge, the child must get minimum B grade in Health and Physical education, Art and work experience, Music and Dance etc.

1. For the consideration of any academic award, a student must appear in all the examinations.
2. A student shall have no claim on any award if he / she has received zero points in discipline (in case of suspension / issue of Improvement Card / use of unfair means in examination) in that academic year.
