Committee Assignment Policy.

Though we make an effort to assign the Committee as per the preferences given, however, we follow a 'First cum First serve Policy' to accommodate these preferences. Thereafter, Committees are assigned on the basis of availability and experience of the delegates. The decision of the Secretariat will be deemed final for the committee and portfolio allotments.

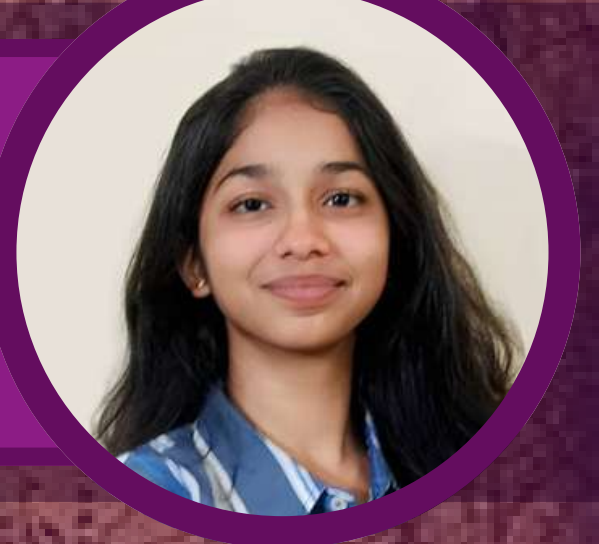
