INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Parents are requested to go through the instructions, guidelines and abide by the School Rules.

Essential Parental Support

- 1. Parents need to check the Almanac / Student Portal daily and follow the instructions given therein.
- 2. Circulars, invitations etc. sent through the children should be duly acknowledged (on page no. 41).
- 3. Parent Teacher Meeting should be attended regularly.
- 4. Parents are required to inform the school if there is any change of address or telephone number.
- 5. Long leave should be sought from the Principal via an application in writing.
- 6. Parents are not allowed to go to the classroom to meet the teachers, except on PTMs.
- 7. No child will be allowed to go home during school hours. In case of an emergency, Principal may be contacted for permission.
- 8. Parents are requested not to send any eatables or gifts to celebrate their child's birthday.
- 9. Parents are requested to deposit the school fee on time.
- 10. All communications should be addressed to the Principal.
- 11. The school provides the best possible amenities and facilities to its students and staff but reserves the right to withdraw / discontinue any of the facilities.
- 12. Parents are not allowed to handover any tiffin / waterbottles and other belongings at the reception during school hours.
- 13. Early pick up will be facilitated from the senior school reception only during emergency, after the permission of the Principal.
- 14. In case of a medical emergency, parents can approach the senior school reception to pick up their child.
- 15. Rules and regulations printed in the Almanac are not static and can be altered at any time at the sole discretion of the management.
- Parents are encouraged to meet the Principal in person for any concern / feedback / suggestions for resolution within the school.

SCHOOL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Students must carry their Almanac, Identity Card and RFID Card, (to be worn around the neck) every day to school.
- 2. Students who come to the school by their own transport should reach the school 10 minutes before the school bell rings.
- 3. Students should be neatly and properly dressed and should wear the full school uniform on every working day.
- 4. Students should wear proper white sneakers along with the sports uniform; fancy footwear is not allowed.
- 5. Boys to sport a **proper hair cut.** Spikes, long hair & trendy hair style are not allowed. **Colouring or streaking of hair is not allowed.**
- GIrls to make plaits. Colour of clips and hair band should be black. Use of kajal, eye-liner, nail polish or jewellery
 is strictly barred.
- 7. No books (other than text books and library books), magazines, comics or papers can be brought to the school without the Principal's permission.
- 8. No monetary collection / donation for any purpose may be made in the school without the permission of the Principal.

- 9. Students should converse in English in the school premises.
- 10. Students are barred from bringing any electronic gadgets to school. They are also not allowed to carry any gadgets when going for trips, excursions and interschool events. If found, they will be confiscated.
- 11. Appointments with Teachers / CR / VP / Principal can be sought only through the Almanac / Student Portal.
- 12. All disputes or proceedings are subject to Gurgaon jurisdiction.
- 13. The school reserves the right to suspend or take strict disciplinary action against a student whose performance is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students / teachers / school authorities.
- 14. Students should not damage / deface any school furniture or write/draw anything on the walls. Strict action will be taken against such students.
- 15. The name, class and section of the student should be clearly marked on all the belongings, including blazers and sweaters.
- 16. Marks will be deducted in the subject if the child is found using unfair means during the assessments / examination. Repetition of the same offence shall result in dismissal from the school.
- 17. Strict action will be taken if the above rules are not adhered to.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE RULES

Parents are required to complete the Medical Form as the health and well being of children are of primary importance. Also, kindly state if the child suffers from fits / convulsions or any other affliction or has had any major health problems. Every possible care will be taken of the child during the school hours and first-aid will be given as and when required. For this purpose, the school has a Medical Room with a nurse on duty throughout the day to attend to any emergency.

Utmost co-operation of parents in maintaining the health and hygiene of the children is sought to ensure their well-being and healthy growth.

In case the child is suffering from any contagious disease e.g. chicken pox, he/she must observe the necessary quarantine period. A fitness certificate is required at the time of rejoining the school.

Parents are required to schedule appointments with doctor/ dentist only after school hours. The student will not be allowed to leave school once he / she enters the school in the morning, on any account.

SPORTS

Sports form an integral part for the holistic growth of a child at Shalom. The school curriculum provides for physical training of each student. The rapidly increasing interest in sports has evinced the need for professional coaching for students. School teams for various sports are trained after school for inter-school, zonal, inter zonal and other competitions. The school already has a proven track record for excellence in most sports at the highest level - International, National and Zonal. The responsibility of the personal belongings lies solely on the parent if the child is participating in any school event. Participation in any sports events beyond school should be reported to the Sports / Subject Incharge / Principal.

The following sports activities are undertaken in the school:

- 1. Basketball, Football, Chess, Karate, Volley Ball, Cricket, Skating, Table Tennis, Yoga, Badminton.
- 2. PEC (Physical Education Card) is an innovative specialized activity designed for students of classes I & II to enhance classroom concept through play way method and teach physical concepts easily while enjoying them at the same time.
- 3. Students are selected and coached by trained coaches to prepare them for State/ National/ International level matches.
- 4. Intra School Sports Meet is organised for students of Primary, Secondary and Senior sections to inculcate a spirit of healthy competition among them.
- 5. Students of Classes I-II will be exposed to sports activities mainly focusing on the fundamental skills.
- 6. Students of Classes III-VIII will be exposed to eight sports disciplines focusing mainly on the major sports.
- 7. Sports Enrichment Program will be organized for all the students.

THE DYNASTY SYSTEM

The school has 4 dynasties: Cedar, Ebony, Maple and Oak. Each Student is allotted a dynasty at the time of admission. Building espirit de corps and camaraderie through dynasty system is an intrinsic part of learning at Shalom. Each dynasty has a warden to guide the students. Various Inter-Dynasty Competitions are organized to develop a spirit of healthy competition among the students. The Dynasty System inculcates the qualities of leadership, co-operation, mutual understanding, tolerance and self-reliance. Various activities such as dramatics, elocution, quiz, group singing, dance, sports etc are organized to build up team spirit and sense of belongingness. The Dynasty Warden and tutors serve as a vital link in the Shalom system, acting as friends, advisors and confidante.

Note:

- 1. It is mandatory for all students to wear the Dynasty Uniform on the day of Dynasty Meet / Competitions.
- 2. It is mandatory for students to participate in all the Dynasty activities / competitions.

PROCEDURE FOR THE SELECTION OF STUDENT COUNCIL

- 1. Students from Primary and Senior School are eligible for nomination to the Student Council for their respective wings.
- 2. Students interested in nominating themselves should have a good academic and co-curricular record to their credit.
- 3. Students should not have missed any assessments.
- 4. Nomination does not entitle one to final selection.
- 5. Shortlisted candidates will then appear before a Selection Board for a one-to-one interaction.

CYBER ETHICS

- 1. Think of the internet as a real place. As your child grows, he or she will go and work more independently on the internet. It is reasonable for you to know where your child is going on the internet and who he or she is hanging out with.
- 2. Keep the computer in a place where you can easily guide your child as he or she uses the Internet.
- 3. Set clear rules and reasonable guidelines for Internet use. Make sure everyone in the family knows the rules and keeps them written down near the computer.

- 4. Remind your child not to share personal information, digital pictures, or credit card information online without your permission.
- 5. Keep a log of the web sites to which you and your child have given personal information. The log should include the site name, the address, the date you gave the information and the user name and password you used for that web site.
- 6. Remember the saying everything you read is not true. Anyone can develop a web site and may include incorrect information on their site. Be very careful about trusting the information you read online. Make sure it is from a reliable source.
- 7. People may pretend to be different than they really are in the anonymous online world. It is you who should decide to avoid a meeting with someone your child has had contact with online.
- 8. Refrain from opening unknown e-mails, files or web pages.
- 9. Since all websites may not be authentic, be careful while gathering information from the sites.
- 10. Accompany your child while he / she browses over the net-be it surfing or downloading music files, entering chat rooms, instant messaging friends, or developing a web site.
- 11. If you are apprehensive that your child or any another child is in danger, don't hesitate to contact the authorities, such as your local police department. Approach the cyber cell.

The school is highly concerned about the student's safety on the Cyber Space.

- i Students below the age of 13 are to abstain from making an account on social networking sites like Facebook etc.
- ii Portable electronic devices are not allowed in school. Students using the same for academic purpose must carry a note signed by the teacher (in-charge of a period). Any unauthorized use of portable electronic devices will lead to confiscation. Students who violate this rule / policy may also be subject to disciplinary action.
- iii Students are not allowed to use any device mobile, camera, internet to photograph or record pictures of another person or school property. Disciplinary action will be taken if any student is found to be participating in, contributing to, and / or encouraging acts of cyber bullying and / or harassment towards another student or staff in or off school premises.
- iv They should not indulge in 'hacking' or attempting to access computer systems without authorization, sending threatening / harassing email, cyber-stalking, vandalism, unauthorized tampering with computer systems, using misleading domain names / or identity fraud.
- V They should abstain from publicly defaming people by publishing material on the internet, email and social networking sites.
- vi Strict action will be taken against students found involved in cyber bullying.

ANTI-BULLYING RULES

- 1. Students are required to behave politely at all times. They should not use indecent language or indulge in fights and quarrels with others in the school.
- 2. Verbal Bullying repeated mocking, name calling, unwanted teasing, or racist remarks will not be tolerated.
- 3. Physical Bullying repeated hitting or kicking, pushing, taking or threatening to take possessions or personal belongings is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Any form of verbal aggression is unacceptable. The matter should be immediately reported to VP, Coordinators or Counsellors of the school.
- 5. The child should be helped out in case if he / she is being left out, ignored or somebody is spreading rumors about him/ her.
- Zero tolerance will be shown towards the student if he / she is found quilty of repeated bullying.

- 7. Bullying behaviour in bus routes should be avoided at any cost.
- 8. Each child should empathize and should not hurt other's feelings and sentiments.
- The school reserves the right to suspend or take disciplinary action against a student whose conduct is harmful to other students.

RULES REGARDING ABSENCE

- If your child is absent, please inform the school, preferably your child's class teacher, promptly in writing. Note: Each day of absence should be covered with a written application or an email to the Principal. For any absence on mandatory dates, permission should be taken in advance failing which strict action will be taken.
- Repeated absence without sanctioned leave or unexplained absence for more than ten consecutive days will render the student liable to have his / her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only on the basis of new admission formalities.
- 3. <u>Attendance on the last day before the vacation and on the first day after the vacation is compulsory</u>. Kindly do not extend vacations on either side. Attendance before and on the days of school functions and assessments is mandatory.
- 4. Parents should fill up the record for Non-Attendance for each day the student is absent from school, stating the reasons for the absence.
- 5. Leave for going out of station should be approved before proceeding on leave.
- Students suffering from any communicable diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class. It is compulsory for the parents to submit a Medical Fitness Certificate before sending their child to re-join the school.
- 7. It is compulsory for the students to complete 80% of the attendance in an academic session to be eligible to appear for the final examination. The percentage, however, can be relaxed on bona fide medical grounds.

RULES REGARDING SCHOOL FEE & DUES

School Fee is to be paid every quarter by the 10th of the first month of the quarter. If the 10th of the month in which the school dues are to be paid happens to be a holiday, then the payment is to be made by the previous working day of the month. The school is extending a value-add-on facility to the parents by sending them reminders through Circular / SMS / Email regarding payment of the fee for every quarter. In case of delay in circular / non receipt of the same, this should not be taken as an excuse for any delay in payment of fee. Online payment of fee is available, kindly contact the Accounts Department for further details.

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF REMEMBERING TO PAY SCHOOL FEE EVERY QUARTER IS THAT OF THE PARENT AND NOT OF THE SCHOOL.

For Classes X & XII, 10th January is the last date for fee payment which will be taken through Demand Draft or Cash. The date of Fee Payment can not be extended due to approaching Board Exams.

LATE FEE RULES

In case of late deposit of fee, the payment will be taken only through Demand Draft / no Cash and the following surcharge shall be levied:

- 1. From 11th to 15th, a fine of Rs. 50 (Rupees Fifty) per day will be charged
- 2. From the 16th to 20th, a fine of Rs. 150 (Rupees One Hundred Fifty) per day will be charged. A late fee of Rs. 75 (Rupees Seventy Five) per day will be charged for Transport Fee.
- 3. If the Fee is not paid by 20th of the same month, the name would be struck off and Re-Admission Fee would be charged.
- 4. As per Haryana Education Code 2020-22, chapter 15, section 3, article 24 (2) a, b, in case, fee of a particular student has not been received within the stipulated time period, the name of the same would be struck off from the rolls of the school & the child will have to be readmitted on payment of fresh charges as applicable.
- 5. In case of a cheque being returned from a particular bank, a fine of Rs.500 will be collected for the same along with a Late Fee as applicable.
- 6. Parents are requested to retain the Fee Receipt of each quarter till the end of the session.
- 7. The payment will be accepted only in form of Cheque / Draft. No cash will be accepted.

RULES REGARDING WITHDRAWAL

- 1. Three calendar months notice should be submitted in writing before the withdrawal of a student from the school, failing which three month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof.
- 2. Fee is to be paid for 12 calendar months.
- 3. No Transfer Certificate shall be issued unless all dues have been cleared upto date.
- 4. Duplicate T.C. can only be issued after submission of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper stating that the same has been lost.
- 5. Original caution money receipt must be submitted in the Accounts Department for the refund of caution money.
- 6. The following categories of pupils may be asked to withdraw from the school (without notifying the cause to the parents)
 - Those who fail to show satisfactory academic progress.
 - Those whose fee is in arrears.
 - Those whose behavior, in the opinion of the School Management, is harmful to the interest of the school.
 - Those who indulge in cheating, misconduct or adoption of unfair means in the Examination / Assessment.
 - Those whose Parents show disrespect to the School Management, Principal or Staff.
- 7. In case of a transfer, the Quarterly Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 8. Those who leave the school in May must in all cases pay the fee for the month of June.

LIBRARY DECORUM RULES

Rules for Students:

- 1. All students have to maintain discipline and silence in the library.
- 2. All students are supposed to take care of the library books and ensure that they are always in good condition.
- 3. In case of loss of the Library Card, a student has to deposit Rs 30/- for issuance of another card.

- 4. Once a book is issued for home, it has to be returned within 7 days or re-issued. Otherwise, a fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged.
- 5. If a student loses the library book, he / she has to replace the same book in the library or make a payment for the same.
- 6. The books picked up by the students have to be kept back at their allotted place in the respective shelves.
- 7. At the time of leaving the school, a student has to return the library books and get a clearance from the librarian.
- 8. In case of urgent requirement of books, the student has to get the written permission from the teacher in class.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. Pledge:

The school pledge should be read aloud, honoured and complied by each student.

2. Punctuality:

Students should be present in the class at the start of the period and be in time for all other activities and functions. Students who arrive late without prior permission of the school authorities will be required to bring a note from the Parents / Guardians which is to be handed over to the Class Teacher. However, when a student arrives late without permission for 3 or more days, he/she will not be allowed to attend school on that date.

3. Attendance:

Attendance on the last day of the school before vacations and the first day of the school after vacations is absolutely essential. However, absence on the first day will be permitted (if for special reason) only with the prior permission of the Principal. Where a student is absent without prior permission, they will be liable for disciplinary action. Students will not be allowed to leave the school early. In case of any such requirement, a note of explanation from the parent is to be furnished to the Principal.

4. General Behaviour:

(a) Students are required to behave politely at all times and should not use indecent language or indulge in fights and quarrels with others in the school. Any behaviour likely to cause hurt to others in the matter of language, religion, caste or community is strictly prohibited.

The following practices are strictly forbidden:

- Spitting in or near the school building
- ii. Disfiguring or otherwise damaging any school property
- iii. Smoking
- iv. Any form of gambling
- v. Use of drugs, intoxicants
- vi. Rowdy and rude behaviour
- vii. Use of violence in any form
- viii. Casteism and communalism
- ix. Abusive language
- x. Disrespect to elders
- xi. Bullying
- (b) Care must be taken of school property and no student is allowed to scratch or damage school property. Graffiti is not allowed. ANY DAMAGE DONE WILL RENDER THE STUDENT LIABLE FOR RECOVERY OF DAMAGES.

- (c) In the absence of the teacher from the classroom, students are required to observe silence and should follow the instructions of the Class Monitor.
- (d) Every student should have his/ her own text book, stationery and other material required for studies. Articles should not be exchanged nor should money be borrowed or lent.
- (e) Indisciplined behaviour in the school bus will result in the students being debarred from using the school bus route.
- (f) A student who uses unfair means in the examination will render himself / herself liable to such punishment as is considered necessary by the Principal.
- (g) The general behaviour of students should be good not only within the school but also outside. Any reported objectionable conduct outside the school will make the student liable for disciplinary action.
- (h) Students found in possession of any reading material, books or magazines of undesirable nature will be liable for disciplinary action.
- (i) Every student should take care of his / her personal belongings. School authorities will not be responsible for loss of personal belongings.
- (j) It is the duty of all students to keep their Class Rooms and other places in and around the school clean and in order. All waste paper and other disposable materials should be thrown in the dust bin.
- (k) Students are allowed to use the White Board and the Smartboard only if asked to do so by the teacher.
- (I) Before leaving the class room at the end of the day, the students should arrange the desks and chairs in proper order, put off the lights and fans, close the windows, throw the waste paper and unwanted materials into the dust bin and then leave the class room.
- (m) Students must report to their respective class rooms on reaching school in the morning.
- (n) Student should not step out of the class without a Class Pass or strict action will be taken against the student(s) violating this rule
- (o) Students going out for matches, competitions etc. must inform their respective Class Teachers in advance or they will be marked absent.
- (p) Students to maintain proper discipline while moving out of their class.
- (q) Students of all classes to carry school bags as per the time table to avoid carrying heavy bags. Classes I & II students should carry the lunch box, water bottle and Almanac to school daily.
- (r) Violation of the rules and regulations of the school and the code of conduct will render the concerned student liable for punishment including removal from the rolls of the school.

5. Discipline:

We at Shalom believe in the development of Values and Ethics. Therefore, the school strives to inculcate a sense of responsibility and moral conduct in its students. To emphasize these qualities, the school has developed a system of disciplinary practices to be followed. For any act of indiscipline, the child will be issued a series of warnings as follows:

- i) First offence Issue of Warning by Class Teacher
- ii) Second offence Issue of Warning by Vice Principal
- iii) Third offence Issue of Warning by the Principal which could lead to home stay of the child.

Apart from these, a circular / letter will be issued to the parents informing them about the same. An act of indiscipline will lead to afternoon detention upto 3:45 pm. Parents will have to pick their child after this.

6. No child is permitted to drive a motorized vehicle to school in keeping with the guidelines issued by the Traffic Police, Haryana.

EXAMINATION BYE LAWS

Code of Conduct

- Students should observe silence at all times during the examination.
- The Teacher/ Invigilator reserves the right to expel any student from the examination room or hall if he/she misbehaves during the examination.
- Use of unauthorized materials like calculators or any other gadgets is not allowed.
- Students who cheat or indulge in any unfair practices during the examination will have to face action by the school's Disciplinary Committee.
- Students sitting for the examination must report to school in proper school uniform.

Before the Commencement of the Examination

- Teachers and Students to ensure removal of all books and scraps of papers from under the table top covers and Class Notice Board. Unauthorized materials are not allowed.
- Students sitting for the examination must adhere to the school rules with regards to attire, hairstyle and accessories.
- Students to be seated according to the Seating Plan in the Examination Room.
- All bags and files are to be placed neatly in front of the classroom or by the side of the hall.
- All students to be in their seats 10 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- Students are to check their pockets to ensure that there are no incriminating scraps of papers, notes and books in their possession.
- No extra time will be given to the latecomers. Students who report 30 minutes after the exam has started will not be allowed to sit for the exam.
- Students to read the instructions carefully after receiving the question papers and ensure that they have received the correct question paper.

During the Examination

- Students are not to communicate with other students. If there are queries, students are to raise their hands and clarify
 the same from the Invigilator.
- Students are not allowed to borrow any stationery from each other.
- Students are not allowed to use the washroom unless absolutely necessary.

After the Examination

- At the end of each paper, each student to verify and ensure that all scripts are handed over as instructed by the Invigilator.
- No student is allowed to take any writing paper, used or unused, out of the Examination Room / Hall.
- No one is allowed to leave the Examination Room/ Hall before the end of the time stipulated for the paper.

Absenteeism during Examinations:

Grades IV-XII

NO RE-TEST will be administered for students who are absent for any of the Periodic Assessments/ Unit Tests, Half Yearly Examination and Annual Examination/ Pre Board Examination. In case of absenteeism, due to medical reasons, a medical certificate cum fitness certificate from a registered doctor needs to be submitted. In such cases, Average Marks would be considered based on the Assessments / Examinations appeared for, subject to approval by the Principal. A prior information regarding the absenteeism should be intimated through mail to the Principal/VP/HM/CT.

Note: If a student is absent for any PA's / Half Yearly / Annual Examination, he / she will not be eligible for the Scholar Badge.

Promotion Policy For Class IX

In order to be declared as 'PASSED'

- 1. The candidate has to secure 33% marks in each of the five subjects separately in the Annual examination.
- 2. The candidate has to secure 33% marks for internal assessment in each subject.
- 3. The candidate has to secure 33% marks aggregate in overall result.
- 4. A student having less than 75% attendance in an academic session will not be permitted to appear in the Annual Examination.
- 5. It is mandatory to appear in all Examinations to be eligible for promotion.

Promotion Policy For Class XI

- Attendance is an important criteria for promotion.
- A child who fails to meet the required 75% attendance is not eligible for promotion.
- Passing in all Unit tests and Term Exam is essential with a minimum of 33%.
- Students should score a minimum of 33% in each subject for promotion to the next class.

Criteria for appearing in CBSE Board Examination for class X & XII

- A child who fails to meet the required 75% attendance is not eligible for appearing in the Board examination.
- Each Unit test / Periodic Assessment is a very important factor for assessing the child's eligibility for appearing for CBSE board Examination.
- Passing in all Unit tests / Periodic Assessments. and Term Exams is essential with a minimum percentage of 33% for each subject.
- Under no condition absence is allowed in Unit Tests / Periodic Assessments / Term Exams / Pre Board Exam.
- The result of Pre Board-I and Pre Board-II will be the final decision for the child's eligibility for board examination.

Disclaimer: - All examination Bye-Laws are subject to CBSE mandates/ notifications and revisions.

Note: Date sheet & syllabus for Assessments will be uploaded on the student portal.

Guidelines for the Scholar Badge:

Scholar Badges are awarded to the meritorious Shalomites. Students are lauded with the Scholar badge at the end of each academic year. All Students from grade III - IX & XI are eligible for the Scholar Badge, provided they fulfill the criteria for the same. Students of grade I and II will be conferred with certificates of recognition based on their merit.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

- 1. The Bus Facility is provided on an obligatory basis.
- 2. Transport fee will be charged for 11.5 calendar months.
- 3. Collecting the students to and from the bus-stand is the sole responsibility of the parents.
- 4. No student will be allowed to come to school in a self-driven vehicle.
- 5. The school authorities have full right to curtail or cancel the bus facility of any student without giving any prior notice.
- 6. The bus routes will be decided by the School Authorities and will not be changed to suit individual needs.
- 7. Any damage caused to the buses shall have to be made good by the students on board and can also lead to expulsion. The decision of the authorities shall be final and binding.
- 8. Use of foul language or indulging in fights within the bus are valid reasons for suspension of the bus facility.
- 9. Request of Parents to permit students to go back from school in some other bus to relatives' homes will not be entertained. At such time, parents are expected to come personally to collect the child after school.
- 10. Change of address must be intimated to the Class Teacher at once to keep the school record updated.
- 11. In case of change in the telephone numbers, the same must be intimated to the Class Teacher immediately.
- 12. Students should reach the designated bus stop 5 minutes before the bus is due to arrive. The bus will not wait for late comers. In case of delay of buses, an SMS will be sent from the school intimating the same to the parents.
- 13. Any complaint regarding the school transport should be reported to the school transport office.
- 14. It is the sole responsibility of the parents, if the child travels by any private mode/ vehicle, to ensure safety of their wards in the van.
- 15. In case of fee defaulter, transport facility will be withdrawn immediately.
- 16. Transport facility will be automatically stopped for the child in case of non-payment of fee by 15th of the month of every quarter.
- 17. Safety of children is the primary concern of every parent. To enhance child safety, bus will be facilitated with GPS tracking system for parents that will help in tracking your child's school bus on the route every day.
- NOTE: If for any reason parents require to withdraw bus facility of their child from school, they need to give one calendar month's notice. The withdrawal form (available in the office) has to be filled in and submitted to the Accounts Office on or before the 7th of a month to enable the completion of the formalities of withdrawal by the end of the month. If the withdrawal form is submitted after the 7th of the month, the subsequent month will be treated as the month of notice period and fee will be charged for that month as well. For example, if the form is received on February 08, then fee will be chargeable for February and March.

^{*}Students who have been absent for Unit Test, Half yearly and Annual Examination will not be considered for Scholar Badges in class XI.

Daily Routine for Walker Children

- 1. Kindly drop your ward 10 minutes earlier than the school timings to the school in the morning.
- 2. Pick up time from the school gate will be 2.15 pm.
- 3. The children shall be handed over only if the parents show the pick up card to the Teachers who are Dispersal In-charges.
- 4. Walker parents are requested to avoid discussions with Teachers during Dispersal Time as it interferes with his / her duty and responsibility as a Walker Teacher.
- 5. Students who commute on their own or are picked up by guardians or drivers are required to submit a declaration duly signed by both the parents. The declaration should include photographs of the person picking up the child.
- 6. In case of walker children going home on their own, the parents will be responsible for the safety of the child.

Private Van

- 1. Pick up and drop of the students availing private van is the sole responsibility of Parents.
- 2. School will not be held responsible for any untoward incident concerning the private van driver. Safety and security outside the school will be the entire responsibility of the parents.
