Students were able to represent different denominations of notes and coins.



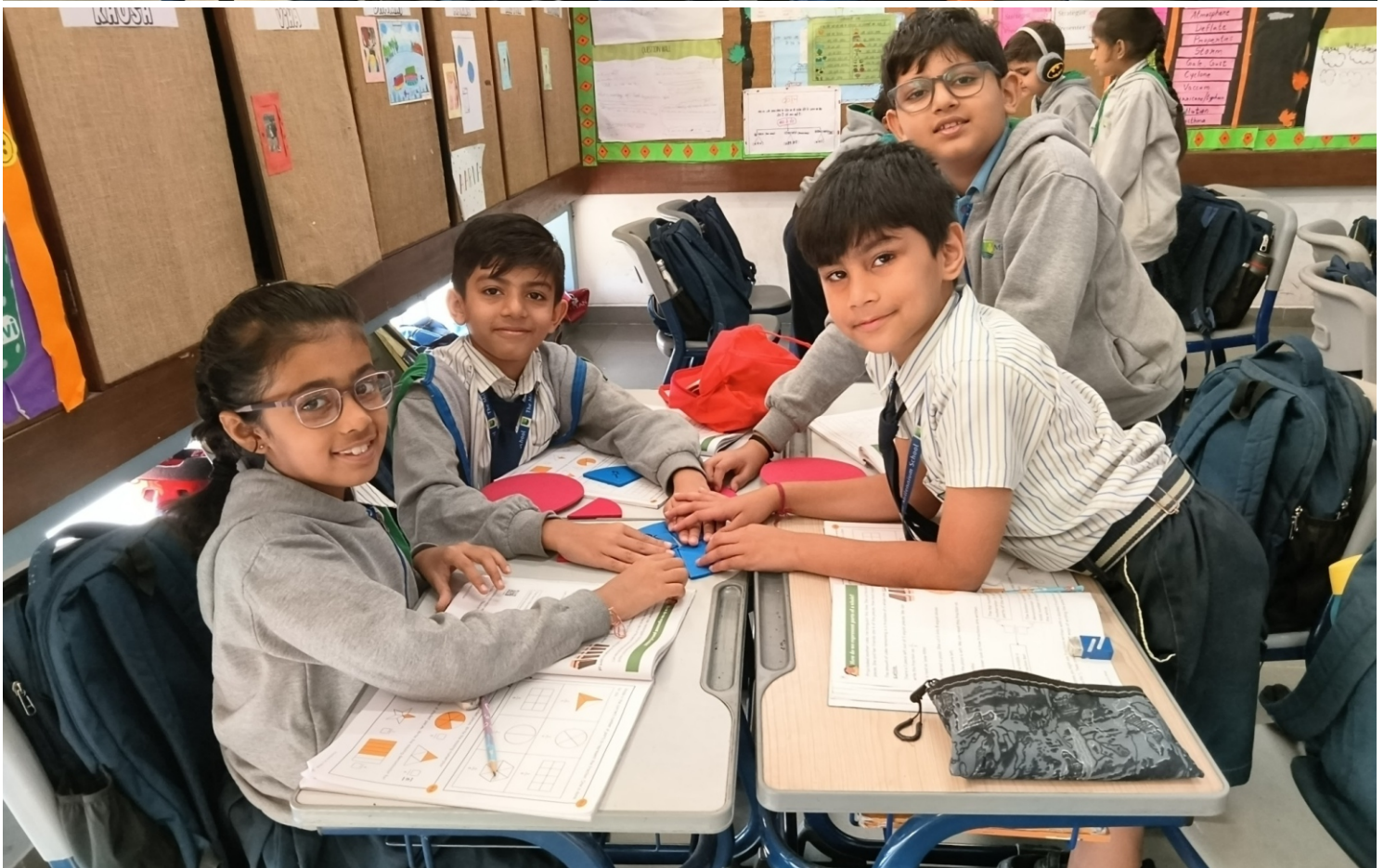
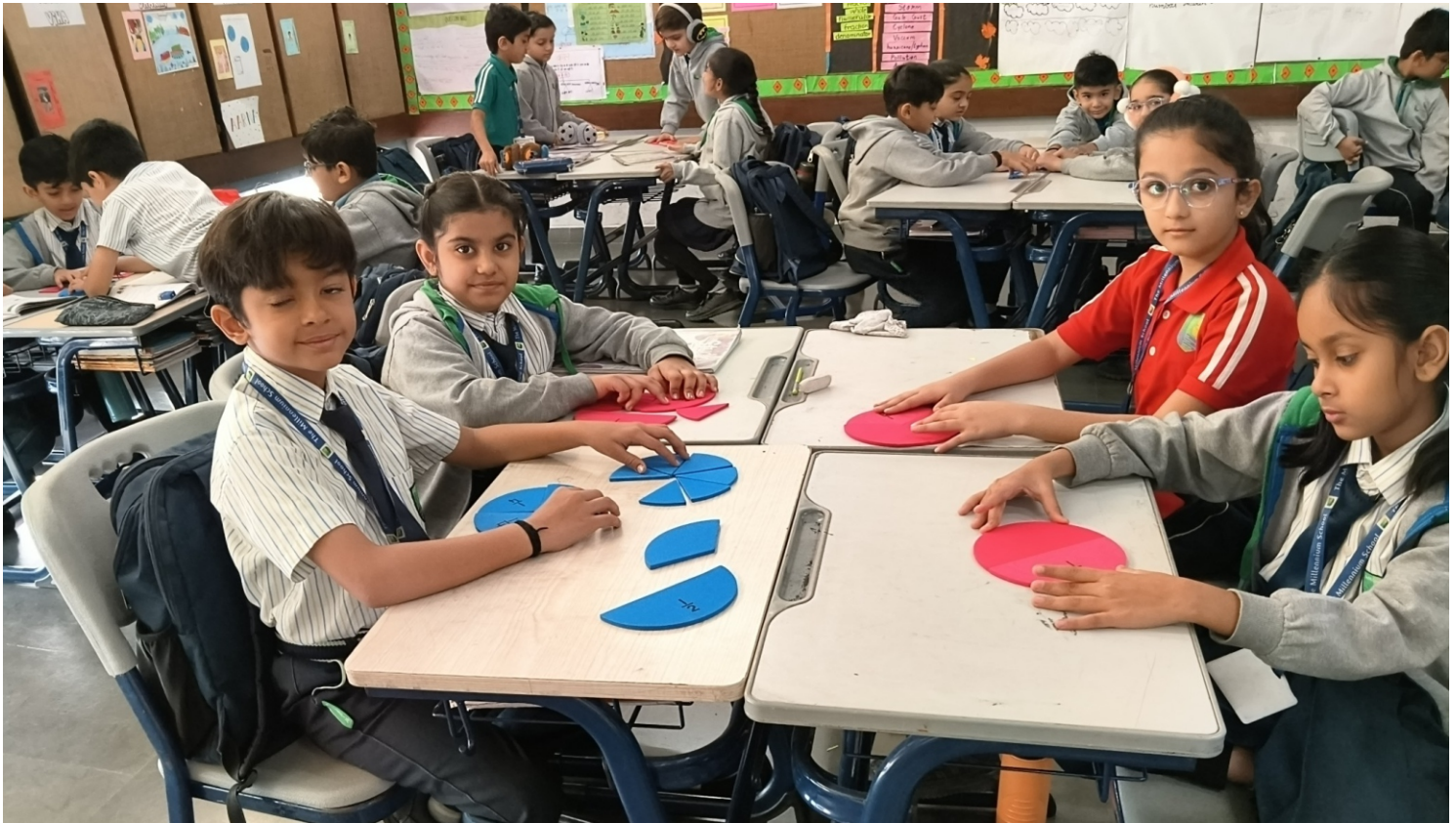

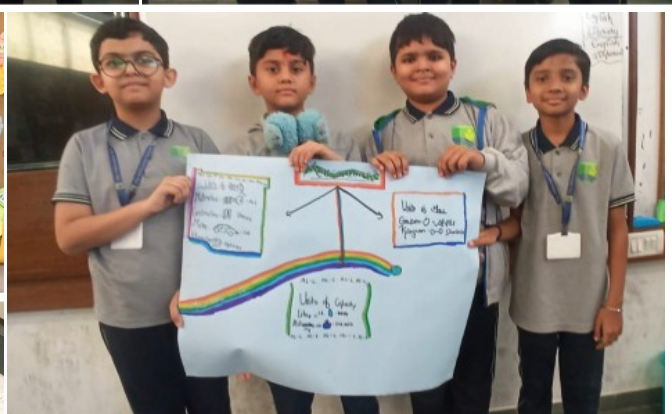
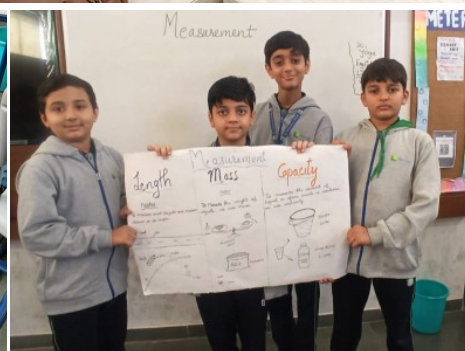
## Measurement Exploration

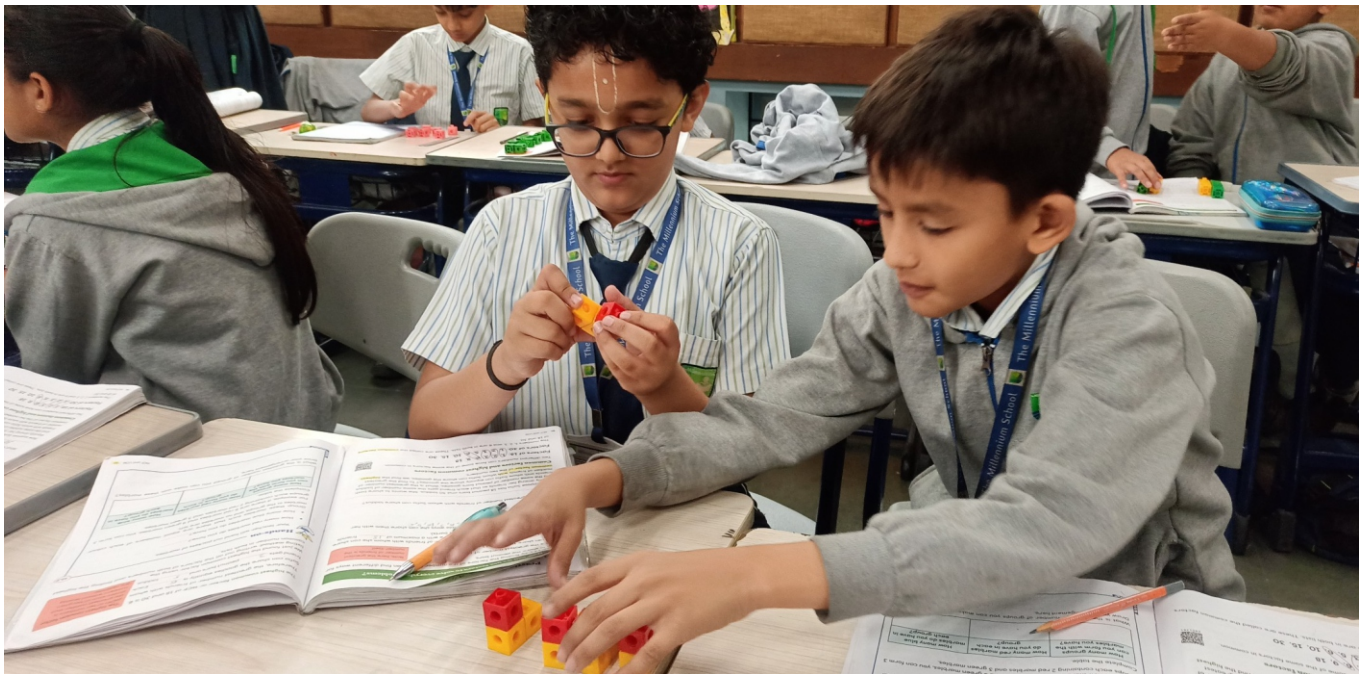
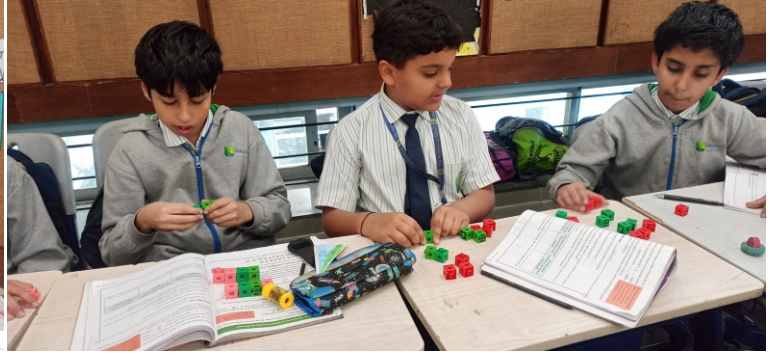
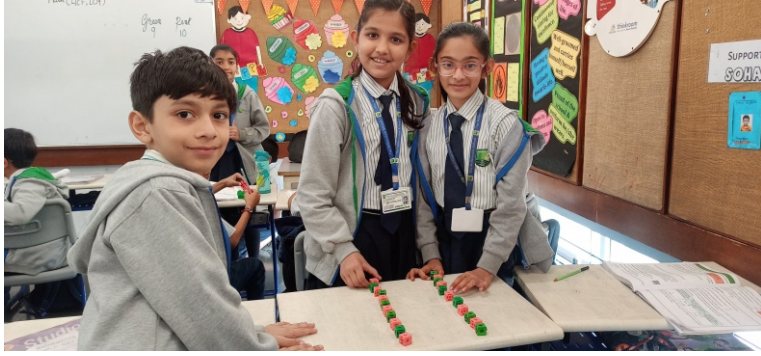
- Students listed and pasted different objects according to their measurement units, fostering hands-on learning.
