A highlight was the exciting video of robots playing football, sparking curiosity and lively discussion among students about the real-world applications of AI.



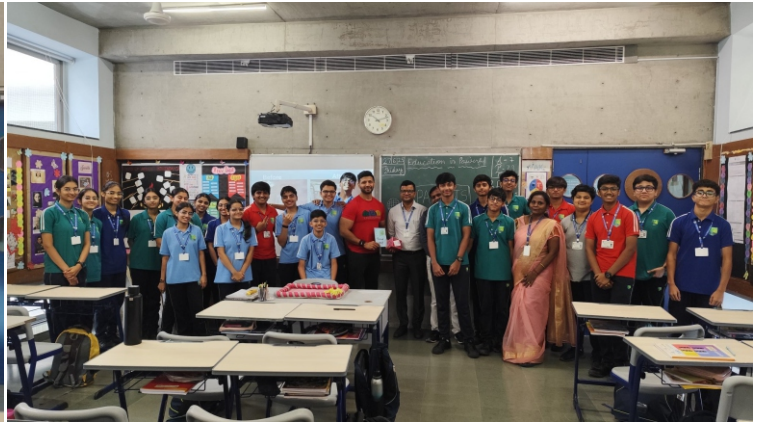
PARENTS PODIUM (IX - XII)

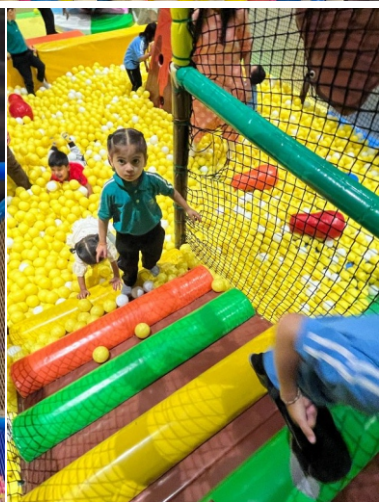
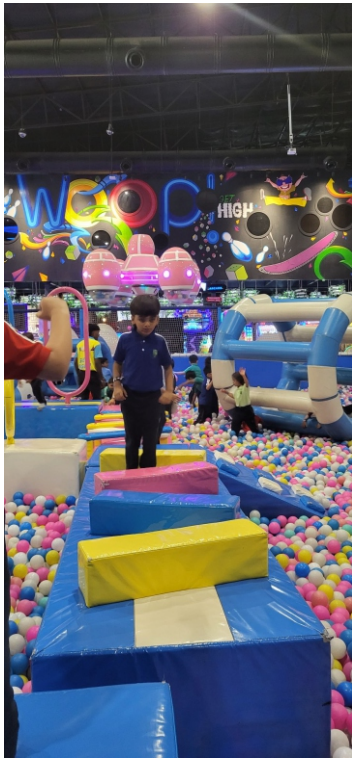

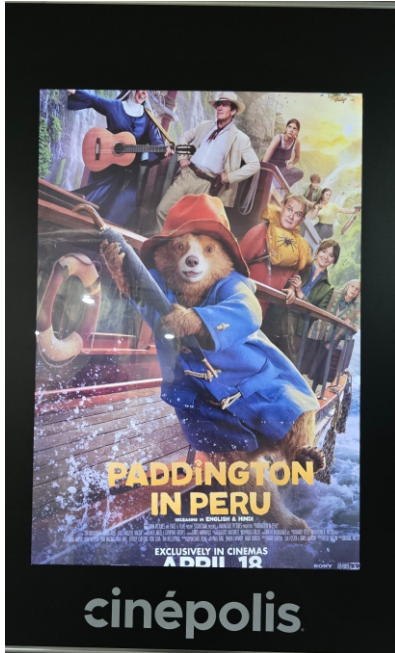

This engaging approach made learning both fun and meaningful, reinforcing key mathematical concepts through real-world experiences.



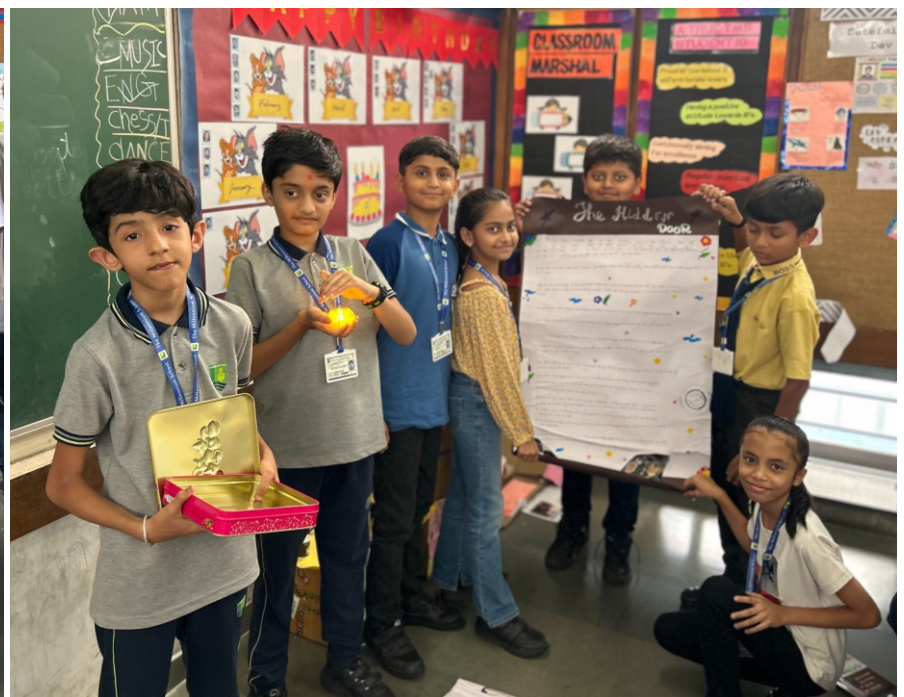
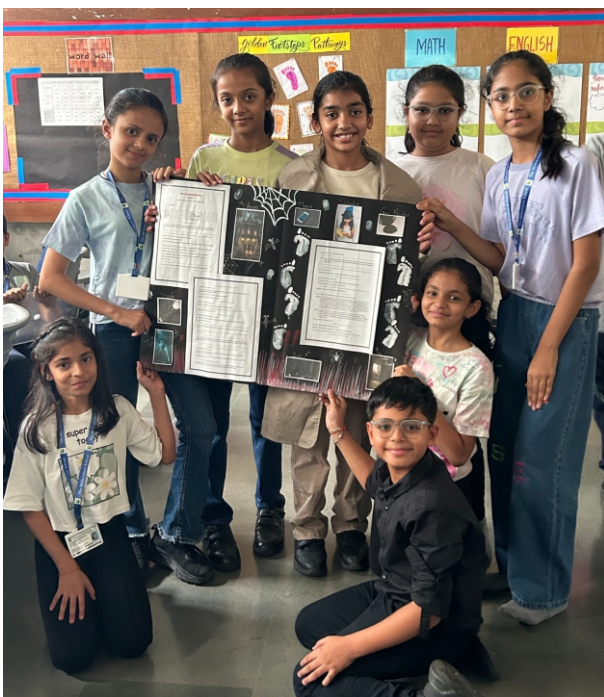
