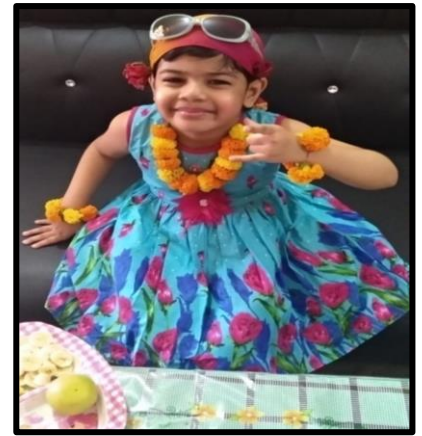
Summer snack chat

Counting spree

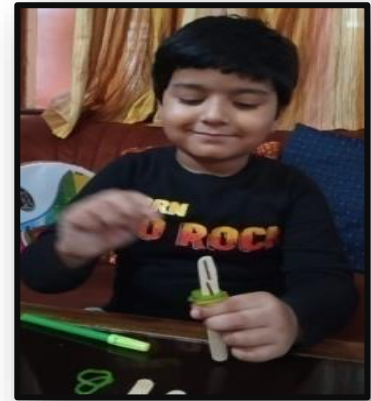
26th May 2020

Our Magnetic Earth

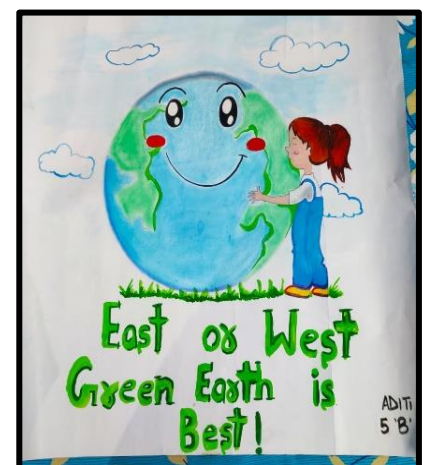
22nd April 2020

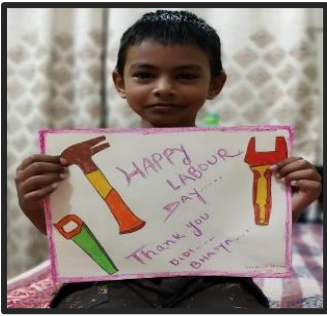


Their presentation claimed to get the Earth back, to restore and to rebuild the Earth in to a beautiful green and blue planet.

Upskill Never Before – Teacher’s Special



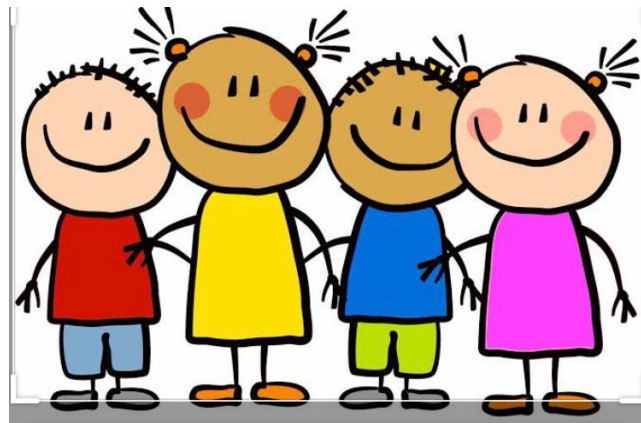
