ADMISSION CRITERIA

(2) **Mode of Payments:** - All fees are payable in advance through **DPS Vindhyanagar App** only on bimonthly basis from 1st to 15th of the month (i. e. April, June, Aug, Oct, Dec and Feb of the session).
